As in many scientific fields, in pedagogy the essay is an integral component of the independent work of both students of pedagogical direction and already established specialists in the field of education and upbringing. An essay is not just a way to present your thoughts and achievements, but also a way to demonstrate your professionalism and competence in this field of activity. Suffice it to recall the fact that the pedagogical essay is one of the first tasks for the participants of the All-Russian competition Teacher of the Year, in which teachers from all over the country participate.

The word essay itself is borrowed from the French language and essay in the original can have several meanings, such as an essay, an outline or a sample. The term is also related to the Latin word.

Essay belongs to the prose genre and usually reflects the author's vision of a situation, his experiences and reflections, personal impressions. This short essay is not meant to give an exhaustive and unambiguous answer to any question or problem, but only to allow the reader to see one aspect of the world as seen by the author and, perhaps, to prompt independent reflection. An essay is distinguished by the variety of topics and areas in which this particular type of statement of thought may be chosen, but most people are familiar with essays from the schoolroom as part of a literature class.

Signs of an essay

Although essays do not require following clear rules of writing and have a free composition, it is necessary to know the main signs of this genre in order to write a competent and interesting work. This list applies to both essays in general and pedagogical essays <u>Online Custom Writing</u>.

What to pay attention to:

Setting a problem within a single topic that is clearly evident throughout the work;

The essay should foster the reader's desire to explore the issue independently and find for himself or herself an answer to the question or problem voiced;

Conversational style of presentation of thoughts, it is necessary to avoid florid formulations and complex constructions, which will engage the reader in a dialogue with the author and his work;

The author's opinion is supported by arguments based on real facts and events;

Although there is no limit on the length of the work and the number of words, it is worth adhering to the saying brevity is the sister of talent.

It is difficult to allocate for yourself a clear plan of a pedagogical essay, but on the expanses of the Internet there are many templates and examples that can help in mastering this genre.

A sample essay writing scheme that can be used as a sample and basis for creative work:

An introduction that includes the topic and problem of the essay;

The thesis or judgment, it should be substantiated and supported by arguments, as well as an intermediate conclusion;

Second thesis, argument or arguments, conclusions;

Third thesis, etc;

General conclusions;

Conclusion.

What to write a pedagogical essay about?

The variety of topics for essays is frightening, because you can express your opinion and try to make sense of almost any issue. The most popular fields are literature, psychology, pedagogy, history, sociology, economics, politics and many others. As for pedagogy, you can write on a huge number of popular topics, for example, about outstanding teachers and educators, about methods and teaching technologies used in the modern educational process, innovations at the state level, global trends, different teaching schools, issues of education and training, the pros and cons of methodological complexes of different authors and publications. The topic depends on the goals pursued, your interests and the flight of creative thought.

Tips for writing an essay

Many beginners have a quite legitimate question where and how to start writing an essay?

Even if you understand how to write a pedagogical essay, you may spend too much time on the first sentences, and, as a result, miss important reflections, or even get confused and get lost in the chosen topic. Therefore, it is important to create all the necessary conditions for comfortable and productive work.

In advance, clearly outline the issue and problematic of the essay, find all the information that you may need when framing your arguments and examples. Remember that you are not enclosed in a rigid framework and just get started. Write down the thoughts that come to your mind, even if you think they are inappropriate. You can always edit them afterwards. If this method doesn't work for you, try starting your essay by posing a question and then unfolding your answer. This option is often used by schoolchildren in their academic papers.

Equally popular is the question of how to end an essay. In the conclusion, you have the task of combining the conclusions of all the arguments and bring to a logical conclusion with one general and most important conclusion. Before that, you can briefly summarize the important thoughts and theses of your entire paper and remind the reader of the problem you outlined in the introduction of the essay.
